

Development Plan University of Warwick

We were commissioned by the University of Warwick to review the University's development plan, advise on the University's expansion and design specific projects.

The development plan provides a framework for the University estate to

develop as an integrated whole and addresses issues including: locations for buildings, routes and landscapes; the need to create a development sensitive to the fact that the campus includes significant amounts of green belt; provision of a framework allowing the expansion to be phased; statutory planning requirements; creating a sense of place and a safe environment; promoting sustainable development; and transportation and accessibility.

Specific projects completed by MJP include the refurbishment of University House to create a student resource centre, and the design of a new plaza and landscape integrating the building into the campus.
