MacCormac Jamieson Prichard were first commissioned in 1989 to prepare a masterplan for the East Site of Queen Mary and Westfield College's campus on Mile End Road, London. The East Site faces the canal and Mile End Park, so it was designed to enable the majority of rooms to enjoy this prospect.

MJP have since designed and completed six projects for the College, including a teaching building and approximately 600

students rooms. Two difficult urban infill sites were also developed for residences.

MJP's low budget Informatics Teaching Laboratory won an RIBA award.
