杰瑞米1987年加入事务所，2004年成为总经理。他也领导文化建筑和学生住宅团队。他是已建成的伦敦女王玛丽学院和正在建设的牛津大学圣约翰学院和贝琉学院项目的总负责。在建筑保护领域，他曾带领团队完成了位于朴次茅斯的历史保护造船厂标致建筑6号船坞项目(Boathouse 6)。他还负责伦敦的青年旅社协会的托奎项目和英国驻曼谷大使馆项目。杰瑞米也积累了办公和综合建筑的负责经验，项目包括位于伦敦圣保罗的造价4千五百万英镑的华威楼以及伦敦卫格莫尔的办公楼。他还参与了著名的巴特西电厂的城市改造项目。

另外杰瑞米设计的许多作品被提名，包括牛津的克罗克学院和潘博克学院，剑桥的索灵学院，布莱顿大学；诺丁汉的劳伦斯亭，斯爵特福RSE剧院和英国驻柏林大使馆。

杰瑞米在PFI项目的经验包括赫得福郡大学扩建，他曾负责位于亦巨皇家好乐威学院的国家传记研究院和一级文物保护单位不里斯托谭朴密兹车站的大不列颠及英联邦博物馆。在过去的两年中，杰瑞米在伦敦学院巴雷特学校教书。他也是 Civic Trust 奖的评委。

Jeremy joined the practice in 1987. He became a director when the company was incorporated and managing director in 2004. He has led the process of transferring ownership of the company into an employee benefit trust which was completed in 2007. He leads our student accommodation and cultural buildings unit. He was and is responsible for completed and current University buildings in Oxford at St John's College and Balliol College and in London at Queen Mary College. In the conservation field, he led the team for the conversion of Boathouse 6, a Scheduled Monument in the Historic Dockyard at Portsmouth, funded by the Millennium Commission. He is responsible for the London Hostels Association's Torquay House redevelopment and abroad, he is responsible for the redevelopment of the British Embassy compound in Bangkok.

He has been responsible for office and mixed use developments, in particular Warwick Court, a £45m building in Paternoster Square, London, and a development in Wigmore Street, London. Also he was involved in the development of proposals for Battersea Power Station.

Shortlisted competition entries include projects for Kellogg and Pembroke College, Oxford; Selwyn College, Cambridge; Brighton

University; the D.H. Lawrence Pavilion, Nottingham; the RSC theatre Stratford and the British Embassy, Berlin.

His experience in PFI's include a bid for the expansion of the University of Hertfordshire. He led lottery funded projects for the British Institute of Biography at Royal Holloway College, Egham, and the British and Commonwealth Museum in the grade 1 listed old Templemeads Station in Bristol. In the last two years, he has been a contributor to the professional practice course at the Bartlett School of Architecture in University College London. He is an assessor for the Civic Trust Awards.

理查·迈克麦爵士是MJP的主席和事务所的创始人。事务所于1972年成立于伦敦。理查广泛的教学于个大学并且发表有关于城市设计和建筑的文章。他常受邀作为建筑设计竞赛和奖项的评审。理查是皇家艺术协会的成员和英国皇家艺术学院院士。他曾担任两界皇家美术委员会的成员和前英国文化遗产执行官。他从1991至1993担任英国皇家建筑师协会主席要职。1994年理查被女王授予CBE这一荣誉，并在2001年受勋爵士。他现任皇家艺术学院论坛主席，曾在1998至2008担任皇家艺术学院建筑委员会主席。理查也是伦敦约翰索恩博物馆的委托人之一。

Richard is chairman of MJP Architects, which was established in 1972 and incorporated in 2002. Richard has taught and lectured widely, and published articles on urban design and architectural theory. He is regularly invited to be an assessor of architectural competitions and design awards. He is a Fellow of the Royal Society of Arts and a Royal Academician. Richard has served two terms as a member of the Royal Fine Art Commission and has been a past commissioner for English Heritage. He served as President of the Royal Institute of British Architects from 1991 to 1993. In 1994, Richard was awarded a CBE, and received a knighthood in 2001. He is chairman of the Royal Academy Forum, was chairman of the Royal Academy Architecture Committee from 1998 to 2008. Richard is also a trustee of the Sir John Soane's Museum.

Notable building projects include:

Cable & Wireless College, Coventry (RFAC/ Sunday Times Building of the Year Award 1994); Garden Quadrangle, St John's College, Oxford (Independent on Sunday Building of the Year Award 1994); Bowra Building, Wadham College, Oxford; Burrell's Fields. Trinity College, Cambridge (RIBA Regional Award 1997, Civic Trust Award 1997, and Brick Award, Supreme Winner 1996), and the Ruskin library, Lancaster University (Independent on Sunday Building of the Year Award 1996; RFAC/BSkyB Building of the Year, Universities Winner 1998; and Millennium Products status awarded by the Design Council 1999); The Wellcome Wing at the Science Museum (Celebrating Construction Achievement, Regional Award for Greater London 2000); and Southwark Station, Jubilee Line Extension

(Millennium Building of the Year Award, RFAC Trust/BSkyB 2000).

Masterplanning projects include the expansion of Cambridge University into West Cambridge and the Phoenix Initiative, a regeneration project for Coventry which won the Royal Town Planning Institute Planning Award in February 2004. Other projects include Building 1 in Paternoster Square adjacent to St Paul's Cathedral and the redevelopment/refurbishment of the BBC at Portland Place. Exhibition design includes Ruskin, Turner and the Pre-Raphaelites at Tate Britain, spring 2000 and Surrealism - Desire Unbound shown at Tate Modern, end 2001.

Major project experience: Liz is the Development Plan Architect for the Universities of Warwick and Birmingham. The role includes producing a new Development Plan for the University Estate, the design of landscape and building projects and providing advise on proposals produced by other consultants. Other masterplanning projects include master planning for UCL in London and the West Cambridge Master Plan for Cambridge University.

Other projects include: Harrow FE College - £89m new building setting standards for the FE sector. This project is also a key element in the regeneration of the town centre and occupies a sensitive site on Metropolitan Open Land. West Cambridge is a 66 hectare site, with teaching and research accommodation, sports, social and residential facilities; West Cambridge Residences – 206 flats for University staff and students; Friendship House, Southwark for London Hostels Association - housing for 180 single people; Southside student residences for Imperial College, London - refurbishment of a listed 1960’s building housing 380 undergraduates; Wychfield Site, Trinity Hall, Cambridge - housing for graduate students; Ballymun estate, Dublin for Ballymun Regeneration Limited - masterplan for the regeneration of a large 1960’s estate including the provision of new homes, social and retail facilities, with extensive community involvement;
