

MJP Architects scoop Awards.

Design Mentor Award -Presentation evening: 6 March, 6.00pm-8.00pm

In recognition of the contributions that MacCormac Jamieson Prichard (MJP) have made to Open House Learning initiatives in recent years, Joann Tang and Julie Morrison have been awarded the first ever 'Allgood Design Mentor Awards'. They are two of 'a handful of outstanding architects' to receive the award for contribution to architectural education. The rewards are being presented at Hopkins Wellcome Trust building tonight.

Joann and Julie have provided support to Open House over several years and we are delighted that both have accepted their awards. A handful of outstanding architects from London practices have been awarded this title, and presentations will be made during a reception on Monday 6 March 2006. This event is hosted by the Wellcome Trust and will take place at their prestigious Gibbs Building at 215 Euston Road, London NW1, completed by Hopkins Architects in 2004.

Architects who have participated in several aspects of Open House's educational work – including CPD sessions, Junior Open House, and the recent OPEN UP programme, will receive a Design Mentor Award. As Design Mentors they will be recognised as ambassadors of architecture education. This is the first award of its type for Open House and for architecture education organisations nationally. It is being awarded in recognition of the inspiration and support individuals have provided through their practises, to Open House audiences.
