Duncan joined MJP in 1994, becoming an Associate in 1999 and a director in 2002.

He is responsible for a broad range of projects, currently including a number of substantial developments in the Channel Islands. Recent projects have ranged from masterplanning and detailed design work for large estate regeneration projects in Greenwich and Hackney, to planning submissions for large private houses in sensitive rural locations. Recent and current clients include Berkeley Homes, Taylor Wimpey and Dandara.

He previously worked on Southwark Underground Station on the Jubilee Line Extension and the design of a new bus/metro interchange in West Bromwich, Duncan then designed the new IMAX cinema in the Wellcome Wing at the Science Museum.

Duncan worked on the BBC's new headquarters in Portland Place where he was responsible for leading the design of facades and internal and external public areas from planning through to completion of Phase 1 in 2006.

His current management responsibilities include ICT policy and Quality Assurance, which successfully achieved ISO 9001 standard in July 2005.

Duncan has a keen interest in the civic role of architecture in the public realm and has served on the jury of the Edinburgh Architectural Institute Award.
