Matthew is responsible for Workplace, civic and cultural sector at MJP. He is a member of the Advisory Committee of the Building Futures group at the RIBA. Matthew's experience covers a broad range of building types at all stages of design and construction.

He was Project Architect for the Intermediate Concourse at Southwark Station on the Jubilee Line Extension for London Underground, responsible for detail and production information for a 'glass cone wall'.

In the Workplace sector, he has been responsible for outline designs for major sites on Baker Street and Wigmore Street, as well as the detail design and construction of Warwick Court, one of three major new office buildings in the Paternoster Square redevelopment adjacent to St Paul's Cathedral, and for the Wellcome Wolfson building for the Science Museum.

Matthew was also the Project Architect for the Clayport Library, which was part of the Durham Millennium project. The library won the 2003 Best New Large Public Library award from the Chartered Institute of Librarians and Information Professionals.

More recently he was involved in the Phase 2 design of the BBC Broadcasting House redevelopment. Matthew is currently leading a major new office development on the waterfront in St Helier, Jersey.

Matthew has been a visiting lecturer at Brighton and Aberdeen Robert Gordon Universities.
