Joined MacCormac Jamieson Prichard in 1999 where majority of work has been in housing and education, including built projects for the University of Cambridge, masterplanning for Queen Mary University of London, and housing for private developers. Leads residential sector at MJP as Head of Housing Group.

Reza was the Project Director for One Harrow, a new £143m, 32,500sqm development which is the cornerstone of LB Harrow town centre regeneration. His role included design team leader and management of a 15 strong in house team prior to construction.

He was the project architect for the West Cambridge Residences and Shared Facilities, set within the West Cambridge Masterplan. He has worked with the University Estates Department and other stakeholders in developing the brief prior to novation in the 2 Stage Design and Build project.

Reza has worked on office developments in London, at Paternoster Building One and Victoria Street, both schemes with sensitive planning contexts, before moving on to housing for students and single people at Belvedere Place Southwark. He has also worked on the masterplan for 1,000 student residences at Queen Mary University of London, as part of MJP's broader Campus Masterplan commissioned in 1989.

Reza is the founder of the London Student Accommodation Forum (L:SAF), a professional network set up to discuss topical issues about student accommodation in the capital.
